Crimes Against Property Team convicts 58 felons

Fifty-eight defendants pled guilty to felonies in Mecklenburg County Superior Court before The Honorable Yvonne Mims Evans. The defendants entered their guilty pleas in administrative courtroom 5350 from Monday, July 6, to Friday, July 10. The convictions were for crimes including residential breaking or entering, commercial breaking or entering, larceny of motor vehicles, and breaking and entering a motor vehicle. Based on the structured sentencing laws in North Carolina, sentences ranged from probation to Marsh Evans' active prison sentence of 101-131 months for a commercial breaking or entering and for being a habitual felon.
