**Trial results in 19-25 year sentence for armed robber**

The week of August 3 through August 7, 2009, the Crimes Against Persons Team tried Roman Vasquez-Guardado and Luis Vasquez-Guardado for an armed robbery inside of a small business. Luis Vasquez-Guardado, age 25, was found not guilty on all charges by the jury. Roman Vasquez-Guardado, age 27, was found guilty on all charges and sentenced to a minimum of 231 months (approximately 19 years) to a maximum of 306 months (approximately 25 years). J. Gentry Caudill, Superior Court Judge, presided over the trial in courtroom 5370 and sentenced the defendant to three consecutive sentences.
