Habitual felon John Oliver tried and sent to prison

The week of November 8, 2010, the DA's Habitual Felon Team called the case of John Kennedy Oliver, 27, for 1) felony possession of a stolen vehicle and 2) being a habitual felon. Oliver was found *guilty* by the jury of possessing the stolen vehicle. The defendant admitted his status as an habitual felon. The Honorable Linwood O. Foust, Superior Court Judge, sentenced Oliver to 77-102 months in prison.
