DA's Property Team convicts two defendants at trial

CHARLOTTE, N.C. – On February 6, 2012, Anthony B. Martin, 20, was tried in courtroom 5150 before the Honorable Yvonne Mims Evans, Superior Court Judge, for 1) felony breaking or entering, and 2) felony larceny after breaking or entering. The jury returned a verdict of *guilty* on both charges. Judge Evans sentenced Martin to 5-6 months in prison; that sentence was suspended pending his successful completion of 24 months of supervised probation.

On February 8, 2012, Robin Elaine Pettice, 31, was tried in courtroom 5150 before Judge Evans for 1) felony breaking or entering, 2) felony larceny, and 3) felony possession of stolen goods. The jury returned verdicts of *guilty* on the charges of 1) misdemeanor breaking or entering, 2) felony larceny, and 3) felony possession of stolen goods. The defendant was sentenced to 10-12 months in prison; that sentence was suspended pending her successful completion of 36 months of supervised probation.

Justin R. Withers, 24, pled guilty to felony breaking or entering a motor vehicle. Judge Evans sentenced Withers to 4-5 months in prison.
