Jury unable to reach unanimous verdict in trial against Tre Barber

CHARLOTTE, N.C. – A mistrial was declared in the trial against Tre Cortez Barber, 19, after the jury was unable to reach a unanimous verdict on the charge of first-degree murder.

The trial was held March 4-12, 2013, in Mecklenburg County Superior Court before The Honorable H. William Constangy, Superior Court Judge.

Barber was tried for 1) first-degree murder and 2) robbery with a dangerous weapon.
