## Crimes Against Property Team tries 2 defendants

CHARLOTTE, N.C. – The Mecklenburg County District Attorney's Crimes Against Property Team tried two defendants during the week of May 23, 2016. The proceedings were held in courtroom 5110 before The Honorable Linwood O. Foust, Superior Court Judge.

Kwamane Paige, 25, was tried for obtaining property by false pretense. The jury found Paige *not guilty*.

Riquan Chatman, 23, was tried for 1) larceny of a motor vehicle and 2) possession of a stolen motor vehicle. At the close of all of the evidence, Judge Foust dismissed the case.
