Jury returns not guilty verdict in homicide trial

CHARLOTTE, N.C. – The trial of Michael Kevin Duncan ended today with a jury's verdict of not guilty. The trial began July 8, 2019, in courtroom 5370 before The Honorable Carla N. Archie, Superior Court Judge.

Duncan, 29, was tried for first-degree murder for the May 2016 killing of 46-year-old Darian Lavon Curry. The jury found Duncan *not guilty*.

Duncan's codefendant, Marsean Allison, previously pled guilty to second-degree murder. Allison was sentenced to 228-286 months in prison.
