Jury unable to reach unanimous verdict in homicide trial

CHARLOTTE, N.C. – Today, a mistrial was declared in the trial of Antonio Fernelle Cathey for the October 2013 murder of 17-month-old Kyiemani Aveah Brewer. The trial, which began July 17, 2017, was held in courtroom 5370 before The Honorable Carla N. Archie, Superior Court Judge.

The Mecklenburg County District Attorney's Homicide Team tried Cathey, 24, for first-degree murder. Judge Archie declared a mistrial when the jurors indicated that they were unable to reach a unanimous verdict.

Prosecutors plan to retry the case at a later date.
