Habitual break-in offender among 46 convicted of property crimes

CHARLOTTE, N.C. – The Mecklenburg County District Attorney's Crimes Against Property Team recently convicted 46 defendants, including a habitual breaking or entering offender. During the week of July 24, 2017, the defendants entered their guilty pleas before The Honorable Yvonne Mims Evans, Superior Court Judge. The convictions were for crimes that included felony breaking or entering, breaking or entering a motor vehicle and felony larceny.

Among the convicted defendants were:

Jamaar Radcliffe, 21, pled guilty to 1) three counts of felony breaking or entering and 2) two counts of being a habitual breaking or entering status offender. He was sentenced to a total of 52-88 months in prison.

Demarcis Davis, 17, pled guilty to 1) seven counts of felony breaking or entering, 2) larceny after breaking or entering and 3) contributing to the delinquency of a juvenile. He was sentenced to a total of 10-30 months in prison. Davis was also sentenced to an additional 5-15 months in prison; that sentence was suspended pending his successful completion of 24 months of supervised probation.

Devontae Crawford, 22, pled guilty to 1) second-degree burglary and 2) larceny by an employee. He was sentenced to 10-21 months in prison

James Jackson, 27, pled guilty to 1) felony breaking or entering and 2) breaking or entering a motor vehicle. He was sentenced to 10-21 months in prison.

Cordell Peters, 18, pled guilty to two counts of larceny of a motor vehicle. He was sentenced to 5-15 months in prison

Note: Almost all guilty pleas entered in criminal administrative court are the result of an agreed upon plea arrangement between the State and the defendant, which is then approved by the sentencing judge.
