Crimes Against Property Team convicts 5 defendants

CHARLOTTE, N.C. – During the week of November 13, 2018, the Mecklenburg County District Attorney's Crimes Against Property Team tried one defendant and convicted five others in Superior Court. The proceedings were held before The Honorable Daniel A. Kuehnert, Superior Court Judge.

Dajuanta Alexander, 28, was tried for felony larceny. The jury returned a verdict of *not guilty*.

When he was called for trial, Carlos Burch, 21, pled guilty to three counts of larceny of a motor vehicle. Judge Kuehnert sentenced Burch to 7-18 months in prison. He was also ordered to pay \$4,250 in restitution to the victims.

When he was called for trial, Shaquan Cureton, 22, pled guilty to 1) four counts of conspiracy to commit robbery with a dangerous weapon and 2) possession of a firearm by a convicted felon. Judge Kuehnert sentenced him to 23-40 months in prison. He was also sentenced to an additional 12-24 months in prison; that sentence was suspended pending his successful completion of 24 months of supervised probation.

When he was called for trial, Kamori Patterson, 22, pled guilty to 1) possession of a firearm by a convicted felon, 2) felony breaking or entering and 3) larceny of a motor vehicle. He was sentenced to 21-44 months in prison.

Eric Jones, 17, pled guilty to two counts of breaking or entering a motor vehicle. Jones was sentenced to 4-14 months in prison; that sentence was suspended pending his successful completion of 18 months of supervised probation.

Felix Duverge, 28, pled guilty to 1) felony breaking or entering and 2) two counts of felony larceny. He was sentenced to 6-17 months in prison; that sentence was suspended pending his successful completion of 24 months of supervised probation.
