Jurors unable to reach unanimous verdict in homicide trial

CHARLOTTE, N.C. – A mistrial has been declared in the capital murder trial of Damarcus Donte Ivey, 33. The trial began September 16, 2014, in courtroom 5170 before The Honorable Robert C. Ervin, Superior Court Judge.

Ivey was tried for first-degree murder and other offenses in connection with the 2009 murder of Adrian Youngblood. Today, Judge Ervin declared a mistrial when jurors indicated that they could not reach a unanimous verdict.
