## **5 defendants convicted of property crimes**

CHARLOTTE, N.C. – In one day's time, the Mecklenburg County District Attorney's Crimes Against Property Team convicted five defendants in Superior Court. The proceedings were held in courtroom 5110 before The Honorable Daniel A. Kuehnert, Superior Court Judge. Court was not held on January 15, 2018, in observance of Martin Luther King Jr. Day, and court was closed January 17-18, 2018, due to inclement weather.

Among those convicted were:

Vikeya Ingram, 29, pled guilty to obtaining property by false pretense. Ingram was sentenced to 5-15 months in prison; that sentence was suspended pending her successful completion of 30 months of supervised probation. As a condition of her probation, Ingram must serve 30 days in the Mecklenburg County Jail.

Marsha Bradley, 32, pled guilty to two counts of felony larceny. Bradley was sentenced to 8-19 months in prison; that sentence was suspended pending her successful completion of 30 months of supervised probation.

Marvin Mann, 25, pled guilty to two counts of misdemeanor financial card fraud. Mann was sentenced to 25 days in the Mecklenburg County Jail; that sentence was suspended pending his successful completion of 12 months of supervised probation.
