DA's Habitual Felon Team tries defendant for property charges

CHARLOTTE, N.C. – The Mecklenburg County District Attorney's Habitual Felon Team recently tried a defendant in Mecklenburg County Superior Court. The proceedings were held March 14-21, 2016, in courtroom 6170 before The Honorable Jesse B. Caldwell, III, Superior Court Judge.

John Fraser Magill, 57, was tried for 1) felony larceny, 2) larceny from a permitted construction site and 3) breaking or entering a trailer. A jury found Magill *not guilty*. As a result of the verdict, the State was unable to proceed on the habitual felon charge.
