Sex offender tried and convicted, sentenced to at least 55 years in prison

CHARLOTTE, NC – Christopher Guy, 39, was convicted by a jury yesterday of three counts of taking indecent liberties with a child, two counts of attempted first-degree sex offense, and one count of first-degree sex offense. His conviction is the result of a prosecution centered on the testimony of two very brave children who spoke out about what the defendant did to them. Prosecutors assigned to the case, Leslie Cooley and Tim Sielaff, along with our entire Office, admire the courage of these two girls that made the prosecution of this dangerous criminal possible.



A jury of twelve citizens dedicated four days of their lives to the consideration of the evidence. Upon the return of the *guilty* verdicts, The Honorable Jesse B. Caldwell, III, Superior Court Judge, sentenced Guy to a total of 666-827 months (approximately 55-68 years) in prison.
