Jury convicts man of voluntary manslaughter

CHARLOTTE, N.C. – Derrick Huey, 57, was sent to prison today after a jury found him guilty in connection with the death of James Love, 49. The trial began July 7, 2014, and was held in courtroom 5370 before The Honorable Eric L. Levinson, Superior Court Judge.

Huey was tried for first-degree murder. The jury found him *guilty* of the lesser-included offense of voluntary manslaughter. Judge Levinson sentenced Huey to 73-92 months in prison.

In October 2011, Huey fatally shot Mr. Love during an altercation on Rogers Street in Charlotte.
