Jury returns verdicts in homicide trial

CHARLOTTE, N.C. – A Mecklenburg County jury has found a man guilty of a conspiracy offense in connection with the 2017 murder of 24-year-old Froylan Turcios Perdomo in Charlotte. The trial, which began January 24, 2022, was held in courtroom 5370 before The Honorable W. Todd Pomeroy, Superior Court Judge.

The Mecklenburg County District Attorney's Homicide Team tried Jose Augusto Diaz-Garcia, 43, for 1) first-degree murder, 2) three counts of robbery with a dangerous weapon, and 3) conspiracy to commit robbery with a dangerous weapon. On February 14, 2022, the jury found him *guilty* of conspiracy to commit robbery with a dangerous weapon. The jury found him *not guilty* of first-degree murder and the robbery with a dangerous weapon charges. Judge Pomeroy sentenced Diaz-Garcia to 23-40 months in prison.

Charges against Diaz-Garcia's codefendant, Carlos Fernandez Rosales, remain pending.
