Homicide trial ends with guilty plea

CHARLOTTE, N.C. – Today, in the midst of his trial, Mangasha Dion Clark, Jr. pled guilty to the 2017 murder of 14-year-old Anthony Frazier. The trial, which began June 6, 2022, was held in courtroom 5370 before The Honorable W. Robert Bell, Superior Court Judge.

The Mecklenburg County District Attorney's Homicide Team called Clark, 24, for trial on the charge of first-degree murder. During the presentation of the State's evidence, Clark entered a guilty plea to second-degree murder. Judge Bell then sentenced Clark to 150-192 months in prison.

Charges remain pending against a codefendant in this case.
