Habitual Felon Team leads trial session

CHARLOTTE, N.C. – The Mecklenburg County District Attorney's Habitual Felon Team tried one defendant and convicted three others who entered guilty pleas during the week of March 6, 2023. The matters were held before The Honorable Carla N. Archie, Superior Court Judge.

Angelo Meadows, 36, was tried for failure to register as a sex offender. The jury found him *not guilty*. As a result of the jury's verdict, the State could not proceed with the habitual felon phase of the trial.

Raymond Glover, 33, pled guilty to four counts of felony larceny. Judge Archie sentenced him to a total of 24-48 months in prison.

Calvin Robinson, 43, was sentenced by Judge Archie to 25-39 months in prison after previously pleading guilty to possession of a firearm by a convicted felon.

Duane Jackson, 55, pled guilty to 1) attempted felony larceny and 2) misdemeanor larceny. Judge Archie sentenced him to 12-24 months in prison, as well as an additional 120 days in custody; those sentences were suspended pending his successful completion of 24 months of supervised probation. As a condition of his probation, Jackson must serve 23 days in the Mecklenburg County Jail.
