Jury convicts man of attempted first degree murder as Habitual Felon Team leads session

CHARLOTTE, N.C. - The Mecklenburg County District Attorney's Habitual Felon Team tried two defendants and convicted one other who entered a guilty plea during the week of June 26, 2023. The matters were held in two different courtrooms and were heard before The Honorable Louis A. Trosch and The Honorable Reggie E. McKnight, Superior Court Judges.

Delvario Boyce, 38, pled guilty to 1) possession of a firearm by a convicted felon, 2) misdemeanor carrying a concealed gun, and 3) being a habitual felon. Judge Trosch sentenced Boyce to 64-89 months in prison.

Davidson Henderson, 27, was tried for 1) possession of a firearm by a convicted felon, 2) felony carrying a concealed gun, and 3) being a habitual felon. The jury found him *guilty* as charged. Judge McKnight then sentenced Henderson to 88-118 months in prison.

Leamon Gray, 36, was tried for 1) attempted first degree murder, 2) assault with a deadly weapon with intent to kill inflicting serious injury, 3) discharging a weapon into occupied property inflicting serious bodily injury, and 4) possession of a firearm by a convicted felon. The jury found him *guilty* as charged. The defendant will be sentenced at a later date.
