6 plead guilty while 1 goes to trial during Violent Crimes Team's one-week trial session

CHARLOTTE, N.C. – The Mecklenburg County District Attorney's Violent Crimes Team tried one defendant and convicted six others during the team's November 4-8, 2024 trial session in courtroom 5170 before the Honorable Matt J. Osman, Superior Court Judge. One matter was handled in courtroom 5370 before the Honorable Louis A. Trosch, Jr., Superior Court Judge.

Christopher Harvin, 37, was tried for assault with a deadly weapon inflicting serious injury. After a week-long trial, the jury returned a verdict of *not guilty*.

Justin Garcia-Rivas, 20, pled guilty to 1) robbery with a dangerous weapon and 2) felony flee to elude arrest. Judge Osman sentenced the defendant to 51-74 months in prison.

Hubert Osborne, 36, pled guilty to 1) assault with a deadly weapon inflicting serious injury, 2) felony larceny, and 3) felony flee to elude arrest. Judge Osman sentenced the defendant to 43-73 months in prison.

Deangelo Handy, 36, pled guilty to two counts of attempted trafficking in fentanyl. Judge Osman sentenced the defendant to 50-78 months in prison.

Alec Foster, 27, pled guilty to two counts of assault with a deadly weapon inflicting serious injury. Judge Osman sentenced the defendant to 30-48 months in prison.

David Concepcion, 32, pled guilty to possession of a firearm by a convicted felon. Judge Trosch sentenced the defendant to 13-25 months in prison; that sentence was suspended pending the defendant's successful completion of 24 months of supervised probation.

Artravius Davis, 35, pled guilty to conspiracy to commit robbery with a dangerous weapon. Judge Osman sentenced the defendant to 29-47 months in prison; that sentence was suspended pending the defendant's successful completion of 24 months of supervised probation.
